

Foodbank at St. Matthew's Redhill - Donor Data Processing

- [1] The Foodbank at St. Matthew's Redhill (the 'Foodbank', 'our', 'us', 'we') is a foodbank. We can be contacted as follows in relation to any data processing enquiries.

- [2] We process personal information to enable us to provide local families and individuals (clients) with essential food supplies to keep them going until a longer-term solution is found. This is our legitimate interest for doing so.
- [3] We may process any of the following personal information about our donors (usually provided to us by the donors directly):
 - name,
 - address,
 - telephone number,
 - e-mail address,
 - organisation name (where applicable),
 - details of donation (date, type, amount),
 - Gift Aid declaration,
 - photos.
- [4] If you donate money, we will keep your personal information for a period after you donate to the Foodbank for accounting/audit reasons. We will keep anonymised data for statistical/analysis purposes.
- [5] If you donate food, we may keep your personal information in relevant publicity (eg Facebook, newsletters). We may also keep anonymised data for statistical/analysis purposes.
- [6] Your personal information is kept safely in locked units (where it is in hard copy) and on secure drives (where it is kept electronically).
- [7] In addition, we have a Facebook page and this page processes data in line with Facebook policies.
- [8] We will share a donor's personal information with HMRC where a Gift Aid declaration has been completed. We will not share personal information except as required to enable its legitimate processing.
- [9] Donors have the following rights in relation to the personal information held by the Foodbank.
 - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.
 - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is wrong.
 - You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.
 - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.
 - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.
 - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.
 - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or you, in certain circumstances.
 - You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights.
 - If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
- [10] If you have any concerns about our use of your personal information, you can make a complaint to us.
- [11] You can also complain to the ICO if you are unhappy with how we have used your personal information.
